WARRANT AND FUNCTION OF THE BOARD

The Prairie Provinces Water Board was established on 28 July 1948 by agreement between the Governments of Canada, Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta. A copy of that agreement is attached to the Sixteenth Annual Report as Appendix I.

The Board's function, as expressed in that agreement, is "to recommend the best use to be made of interprovincial waters in relation to associated resources in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta and to recommend the allocation of water as between each such province of streams flowing from one province into another province."

The duties of the Board are set out in detail in the agreement. Briefly they are:

- (a) to collate and analyze existing data;
- (b) to determine what other data are required from time to time;
- (c) to recommend the allocation of water of any interprovincial stream; and
- (d) to report on any questions relating to projects for the utilization or control of common river or lake systems.

REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES IN 1969

AMENDMENT TO 1948 AGREEMENT

With the signing of the Apportionment Agreement on 30 October 1969, between the governments of Canada and the Prairie Provinces, the Agreement of 28 July 1948 became amended. This 22nd Annual Report is thus concerned with the activities of the Board, as originally constituted, from 1 January 1969 to 30 October 1969.

MEETINGS IN 1969

The Board held three meetings in 1969; on 21 January, 14 July and 15 October. The three meetings were held in Regina.

APPORTIONMENT

Discussions continued in 1969 between officials of the Prairie Provinces and Canada on the question of apportionment of interprovincial waters. The negotiations between Saskatchewan and Manitoba, and the negotiations between Alberta and Saskatchewan having been concluded, led to the drawing up of two interprovincial agreements and a Master Agreement between Canada and the Governments of Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba. These agreements were signed on 30 October 1969.

The Master Agreement brought the interprovincial agreements into force and effect and amended the agreement of 28 July 1948 whereby

the Prairie Provinces Water Board was originally constituted. By virtue of this amendment, the Prairie Provinces Water Board was reconstituted and charged with the administration of the Master Agreement.

DATA NETWORK PLANNING

Prior to 30 October, the Committee met on one occasion in 1969, on 24 September, in Regina. During the previous months, there was an exchange of correspondence on the proposed hydrometric network study, put forward by the Water Survey of Canada, and also on the terms of reference for the consulting engineers who would be engaged.

In reporting to the Chairman of the Board by a letter of 25th September 1969, the Chairman of the Committee expressed its concern that the Water Survey of Canada study would provide for only minimal consideration of meteorological network requirements and streamflow forecasting needs. The Committee was also requesting a better definition of their terms of reference in regard to the study and sought further direction from the Board in this regard.

These and other related matters were considered by the Board at the meeting of 15 October. After some discussion, it was agreed that the Chairman should write to the Director of the Inland Waters Branch expressing the regret of the Board that the proposed study did not fully meet the needs for planning a hydrometeorological network; that time limitations would curtail the cooperation and participation of the provinces, and that instead of the consultants meeting with the provinces individually, they should meet with the Data Network

Planning Committee. It was also agreed that the Data Network Planning Committee in turn should meet with the consultants and provide the necessary technical guidance and advice that the study required and that it would be possible to provide within the existing physical and time limitations.

SASKATCHEWAN RIVER AT THE PAS

A study into the effect of Lake Diefenbaker on flood peak flow reduction at The Pas reached the draft stage in July. Subsidiary investigations are completed. The report will be available by July 1970.

OTHER REPORTS AND STUDIES

- 1. The "Compilation of Runoff Records for the Canadian Prairies" was updated to 1967.
- 2. The "Index to the Prairie Provinces Water Board Minutes" was updated to 1969.
- 3. In support of the updating of Prairie Provinces Water Board Report
 No. 5 Supplement B, a computer programme was developed which
 prints out tables of evaporation, precipitation and net evaporation
 for the 15 key stations on the prairies. This information was
 also forwarded to the Saskatchewan-Nelson Basin Board upon their
 request.
- 4. An estimate of streamflow depletions for the Saskatchewan River

System is kept current by the Engineering Secretariat. A chart on the following page provides a graphical comparison between these depletions and the recorded flows at Saskatoon and The Pas.


5. A tabulation of "Acreage Actually Irrigated in the Alberta portion of the South Saskatchewan Basin" has been prepared and may be found immediately following the flows and depletions graph. The tabulation is based primarily on material supplied by the Alberta Water Resources Office.


